In Clinton, we provide hot meals in our dining rooms and delivered to the homebound, offer services that older adults can use, and present fitness and recreational opportunities that seniors enjoy. In both locations, we offer exercise classes in the center and online, and provide care management services including benefits enrollment and Medicare information.
