### A note from our Executive Director:

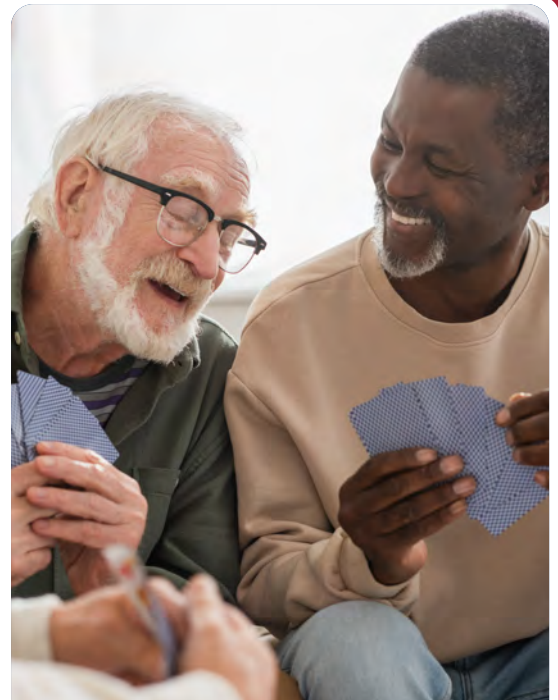

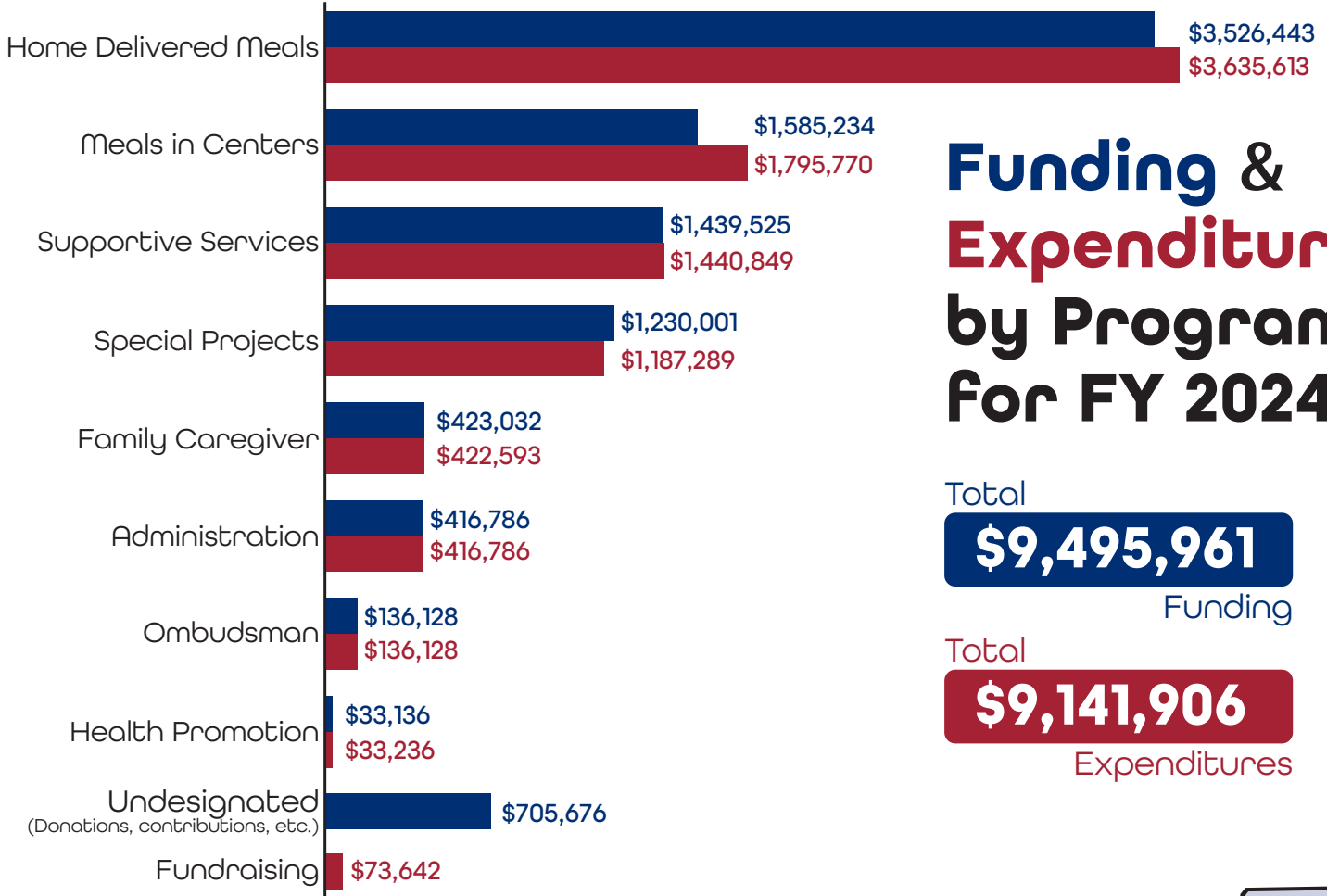

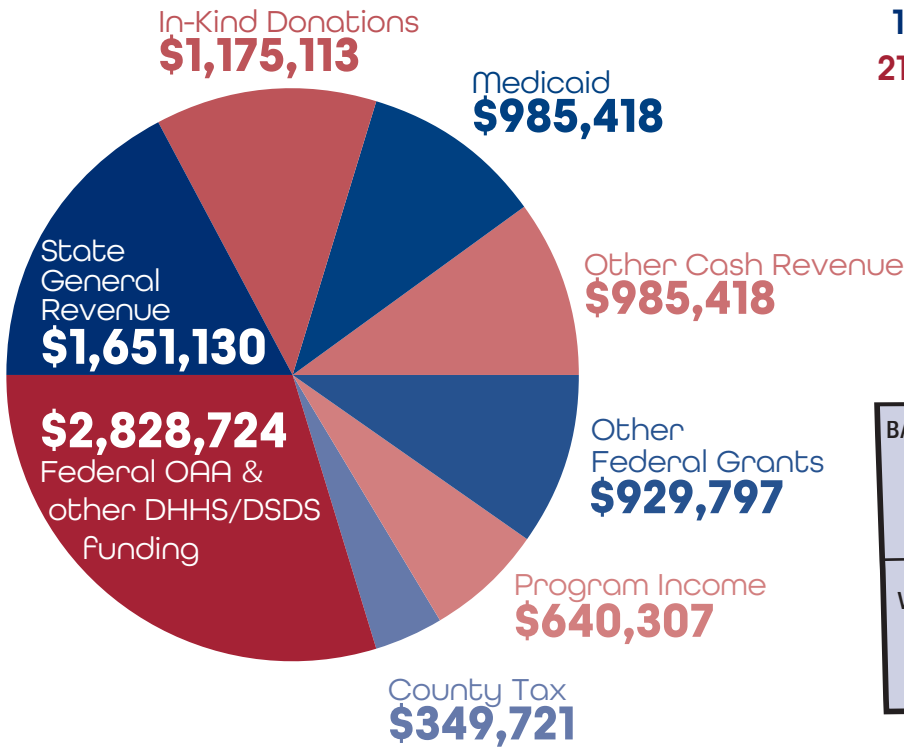


# Funding & Expenditures by Program for FY 2024

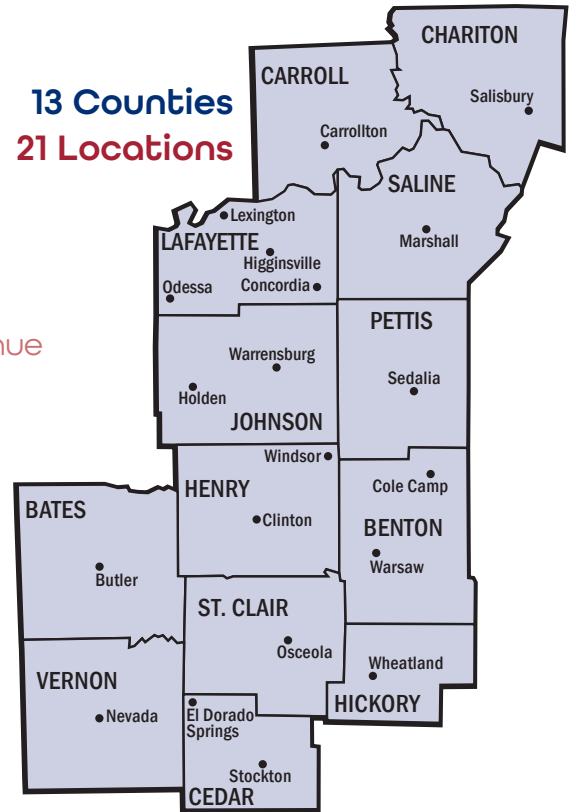
