**Nutrition Programs**

Heart-healthy, nutritious, and delicious meals are offered through 18 senior centers. Home-delivered meals are available to qualified, homebound seniors.

**Family Caregiver Services**

Information, assistance, training, care coordination, respite services (designed to give caregivers a break from the demands of their caregiver responsibilities), and supplemental services designed to support the caregivers. Kinship support for relatives raising children.

**Transportation**

Transportation for older adults who need access to a senior center, essential business, grocery shopping, and medical services in their area and to larger cities.

**Information and Assistance**

Certified, local professionals who provide answers to all types of questions on topics such as planning ways for seniors to remain independent at home, caregiver support, in-home services, transportation, and more. We connect individuals to services in the community and to our care management programs.

**Volunteer Opportunities**

Volunteers are a vital, integral part of the day-to-day operation of all our services. We have a variety of volunteer opportunities available.

**Long-Term Care Ombudsman**

Thinking about long-term care facilities? Ombudsmen provide information on area nursing homes. They also provide nursing home residents with a network of trained advocates who regularly visit. The ombudsmen address residents' and families' concerns and needs.

**In-Home Services**

An array of temporary support programs to allow the consumer to recover at home after an illness. Services offered are homemaker, personal care, and telephone reassurance.

**Care Management**

One-on-one, personalized guidance for older adults and caregivers to receive specific care and resources based on their individual situations.

**Insurance Counseling**

Information and assistance about Medicare and Medicaid. We can advise you about eligibility and help you enroll. Our unbiased, trained navigators can let you know about extra help that might be available for you to help pay premiums and coinsurance. Through the Missouri SMP (Senior Medicare Patrol), we offer guidance to help you prevent, detect, and report Medicare and Medicaid abuse and fraud.

**Health & Wellness Programs**

A variety of programs that offer exercise and wellness education to promote health and socialization such as: Chair One Fitness, Matter of Balance, Drums Alive, Tai Chi, EnhanceFitness, Chair Yoga, and more.
